<i>Gymnopilus ventricosus</i>	Western Jumbo Gym	Growing in clumps on dead pine
<i>Gyromitra californica</i>	Umbrella false morel	Dark brown cap
<i>Gyromitra infula</i>	Hooded False Morel	Red/brown cap
<i>Helvella dryophila</i>	Oak-loving black elfin saddle	ex - <i>lacunosa</i>
<i>Helvella vespertina</i>	Western black elfin saddle	ex - <i>lacunosa</i>
<i>Hygrocybe singeri</i>	Witches hat	ex – <i>conica</i> , yellow-orange cap
<i>Hygrophoropsis aurantiaca</i>	False chanterelle	
<i>Hypholoma fasciculare</i>	Sulfur Tuft	Clustered on pine log
<i>Hypomyces chrysospermus</i>	Boletus eater	
<i>Inocybe insinuata</i>	Fiberhead	
<i>Laccaria amethysteo-occidentalis</i>	Amethyst laccaria	
<i>Laccaria laccata group</i>	Lack luster laccaria	Pink gills
<i>Lactarius alnicola</i>	Golden milk cap	
<i>Lactarius deliciosus</i>	Delicious milk cap	All orange and then turns green
<i>Lactarius rubidus (var. fragilis)</i>	Candy cap	orange

<i>Leratiomyces ceres</i>	Chip Cherries	Small red/brown cap
<i>Leratiomyces percevalii</i>	Mulch Maids	Beige to golden cap, nontoxic poor taste
<i>Leucopaxillus albissimus</i>	Large white leucopaxillus	
<i>Leucopaxillus gentianeus</i>	Bitter brown Leucopaxillus	ex. - <i>L. amarus</i> , velvet cap
<i>Lycoperdon foetidum or nigrescens</i>	Black puffball	
<i>Lycoperdon perlatum</i>	Common or Gemmed puffball	
<i>Marasmius ordeades</i>	Fairy ring mushroom	In grassy areas
<i>Marasmius calhouniae</i>	Calhoun's Pinwheel	
<i>Marasmius species</i>	Pine Needle Pinwheel	
<i>Mycena capillaripes</i>	Bean Sprout Mycena	
<i>Mycena leptocephala</i>	Dark Mycena or Pine Needle Pinwheel	
<i>Mycena murina</i>	Pine Needle Mycena	
<i>Mycena purpleofusca</i>	Purple Pine Cone Mushroom	Grows on pine cones
<i>Mycena species</i>	Little brown mushroom	
<i>Omphalotus olivascens</i>	Western Jack-o-lantern mushroom	
<i>Onnia (Triquetra?)</i>	False Dyer's Polypore	
<i>Panaeolus campanulatus or papilionaceus</i>	Bell-shaped panaeolus	
<i>Paxillus panuoides</i>	Fan Pax	Syn. - <i>Tapinella panuoides</i>
<i>Phaeolus schweinitzii</i>	Dyer's polypore	
<i>Pholiota spumosa group</i>	Slender Pholiota	
<i>Pholiota velaglutinosa</i>	Slimy-Veiled Pholiota	Growing on woody debris
<i>Phyllotopsis nidulans</i>	Stinking Orange Mock Oyster	
<i>Pistolithus tinctorius or arhizus</i>	Dead man's foot	
<i>Pleurotus ostreatus group</i>	Oyster mushroom	
<i>Pluteus exilis</i>	Western Deer Mushroom	
<i>Pseudosperma sororium</i>	Corn-silk Fiberhead	
<i>Ramaria rasilispora</i>	Yellow coral mushroom	
<i>Rhizopogon occidentalis</i>	False truffle, Western Pogie	ex. - <i>R. ochraceorubens</i>

<i>Russula emetica</i>	Emetic Russula	Not in CA
<i>Russula fragrantissima</i>	Fragrant or Fetid Russula	Not in CA
<i>Russula queletii group</i>	Fruity Brittlegill	Purple cap/purple stalk
<i>Russula sanguinea or rhodocephala</i>	Rosy stemmed russula	Red cap/pink stalk
<i>Sparassis radicata</i>	Cauliflower mushroom	ex - <i>crispa</i>
<i>Stereum hirsutum</i>	False Turkey Tail	Growing on dead oak
<i>Stropharia ambigua</i>	Ambiguous or Questionable Stropharia	
<i>Suillus brevipes</i>	Short stem slippery jack	Under Pines, dark cap
<i>Suillus fuscotomentosus</i>	Poor Man's Slippery Jack	Under Pines
<i>Suillus granulatus/granulosipes</i>	Granulated Slippery Jack	Under Pines, not in mykoweb
<i>Suillus luteus</i>	(Yellow) Slippery jack	Under Pines
<i>Suillus pungens</i>	Pungent slippery jack	Under Pines
<i>Trametes versicolor</i>	Turkey tails	Growing on dead oak
<i>Tremella aurantia or naematelia</i>	Witch's Butter	Growing on dead oak
<i>Tremella foliacea</i>	Brown Witch's Butter	Growing on dead oak
<i>Trichaptum abietinum</i>	Purple Turkey Tail	Growing on dead pine
<i>Trichia varia</i>	Slime Mold	Growing on dead pine
<i>Tricholoma dryophilum</i>	Oak-loving Trich	
<i>Tricholoma equestre group</i>	Canary Trich or Yellow Knight or Man on Horseback	Syn – <i>T. flavovirens</i>
<i>Tricholoma imbricatum</i>	Imbricate Tricholoma	
<i>Tricholoma muricatum</i>	Red-Brown Tricholoma	
<i>Tubaria furfuracea</i>	Fringed Tubaria or Scufy Twiglet	
<i>Volvariella speciosa</i>	Common Volvariella	On Coastal Bluff, syn <i>Volvopluteus gloiocephalus</i>
<i>Xerocomellus atropurpureus</i>	Zeller's bolete	syn – <i>Boletus</i> , ex – <i>zelleri</i> (in CA but split off) red stalk
<i>Xerocomellus diffractus</i>	Cracked-cap bolete	ex - <i>Boletus chrysenteron</i>
<i>Xerocomellus dryophilus</i>	Oak loving bolete	syn - <i>Boletus</i>
